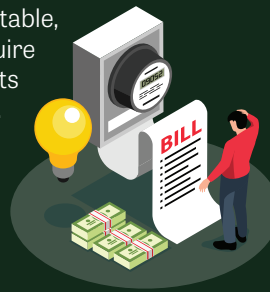


1 VENDOR IS SHUTTING DOWN SUPPORT
